

NOTICE OF HEARING

On December 18, 1980, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission published in the <u>Federal Register</u> (45 Fed. Reg. 83360) a notice of an opportunity for a hearing on the application of the Kansas Gas and Electric Co., et al., for an operating license at Wolf Creek Generating Station, Unit 1, in Coffey County, Kansas.

Timely requests for a hearing and intervention have been received from Wanda Christy, Mary Ellen Salava and Kansas for a Sensible Energy (KASE) and contentions submitted by the petitioners have been approved by the Board. The petitions of Francis Blaufuss and the Missouri-Kansas Sertion of the American Nuclear Society to intervene have been denied. The request of the Missouri Public Service Commission and the Kansas Corporation Commission to participate as an interested State agency are approved.

A hearing will be conducted in this proceeding. At the appropriate time the Board will hold a prehearing conference pursuant to 10 CFR 2.752. The Board is invited to attend any prehearing conference as well as the evidentiary hearing. In accordance with the rules, any person not a party to the proceeding, will be permitted to make a limited appearance statement at any session. Person desiring to make a limited appearance statement are requested to inform the Secretary of the Commission, U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, D.C. 20555.
