SUGGESTIONS ON FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OF CONSUMERS POWER COMPANY

Consumers Power Company respectfully submits to the Commission that the voluminous record compiled in this proceeding to date is more than ample to support findings that there is reasonable assurance (1) that safe off-site disposal of radioactive waste from nuclear power plants will be available between 1997 and 2006; (2) that, pending shipment to permanent disposal facilities, spent fuel can be safely stored indefinitely in at-reactor and away-from-reactor storage facilities; and (3) that sufficient away-fromreactor storage will be available to store any fuel which cannot for any reason be stored at reactor. Since the record now appears to be complete, Consumers Power Company also urges the Commission to find that no further factfinding procedures are necessary for this rulemaking. In support of this assertion Consumers Power Company hereby adopts the contents of the Suggestions on Further Proceedings of the Utility Nuclear Waste Management Group-Edison Electric Institute. In addition, Consumers Power Company recommends that the Commission adopt procedures for reaching findings on the existing record as set forth in the Suggestions With Respect to Further Proceedings of the Attorney General of the State of New York of October 2, 1980.
