# FOURTH STIPULATION REGARDING CERTAIN SUFFOLK COUNTY CONTENTIONS

I.

Technical and legal representatives of the Applicant, the NRC Staff and Suffolk County (SC or County) have continued their efforts to facilitate informal discovery by SC, as well as to resolve and/or particularize certain SC contentions. As a result of these efforts, the Applicant, Staff and County stipulate that:

A. The following SC contentions will be pursued no further in this proceeding either because pertinent County concerns have been resolved or because they will be covered in other SC contentions: 3a(iii),  $\frac{1}{4}a(xv)$ , 11a(i), 12a(vii) and 20a(ii).

<sup>1/</sup> As a result of informal discovery on contention 3a(iii), SC identified a concern with operational procedures for fuel channel change-out. The parties agree that SC may particularize a contention or contentions on this issue if they so desire.

B. SC contentions 3a(i) and 3a(ii) encompass a number of generic unresolved safety issues. In the course of informal discussions, SC indicated that they were interested in pursuing the following issues from the attached list (enclosure 1): II.4, II.5A, II.5B, II.7, II.8, II.9, IIB.2, IIB.3, IIC.5, IIC.7, IID.1 and IIE.1. Additionally, SC was concerned with NRC Task Action Plans A-24 and A-31. Of these issues, the following will be pursued no further in this proceeding either because pertinent County concerns have been resolved or because they will be covered in other SC contentions: II.4, II.9, IIB.3, IIC.7, and IIE.1.

#### II.

The parties to this stipulation request that the Board accept the agreements set out in Part I above.

## III.

There will be continuing efforts by the Applicant, Staff and County to resolve and/or adequately particularize the remaining SC contentions. The Board will be kept informed of these efforts.
