- 2. In response to Reference 1a, addressed in the sequence order of inquiry, the AMCOM Safety Office offers the following responses.
- a. The date when the co-location and inventory at Temple, TX was achieved or will be achieved:

The single laser unit to be co-located to Temple, TX arrived there on 25 November 2019. A previously contracted vendor pick-up was made on 21 November 2019 ahead of the arrival of this last laser to be disposed. Previously contracted activities of the vendor did not allow accommodating the last arriving laser in the 21 November 2019 disposition.

- b. A progress update regarding final inventory and licensed material dispensation.
 - (1) As of 25 November 2019, laser inventory is as follows:
