

OF LICENSING BOARD ORDER ADMITTING LATE INTERVENOR

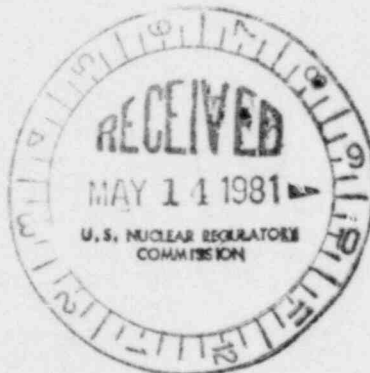


