Dear Neal:

We are in the process of completing a transaction involving the importation of the U. S. 495 KgU with an enrichment in U-235 of 3.42%.

The enriched uranium is contained in acceptable type 30B UF<sub>6</sub> cylinders. Actual transport will be handled by Edlow International.

The enriched uranium is presently owned by Gemeinschaftskernkraftwerk Tullnerfeld (GKT), Postfach 477, Marc Aurel-Strasse 4, A-10111 Vienna 1, Austria. It was originally provided under DOE Enrichment Services contract UES/AU/100 for use in fueling the GKT power reactor and is currently stored at Reactor Brennelement Union GmbH (RBU), at Hanau, Federal Republic of Germany.

The subject material is being purchased by SWUCO and will be imported to the United States and delivered in June, 1981 to a DOE gaseous diffusion plant for use as feed. As this enriched uranium is urgently needed to satisfy a feed delivery and subsequent enriched uranium product schedule, your assistance in the issuance of an import license will be appreciated.
