Chairman Smith:

I am writing to appeal to you to take affirmative action to expeditiously restart Unit 1, Three Mile Island.

The economic impact on the municipal services budget for the Borough of Myerstown for the calendar year 1980 was approximately \$7,909. This relates to a per capita cost of approximately \$2.17. While this per capita cost may be minimal in some eyes, it is only part of the economic conditions being faced by our residents and especially our fixed income retirees.


For your information, the breakdown of the areas where the purchased power can be accurately calculated; they are as follows:

Waste Water Treatment	\$4,436
Water Supply	\$1,942
Community Swimming Pool	\$ 112
Street Lighting	\$1,420

This does not include the extra costs incurred for the Community Library; the Borough Office; Highway Equipment Garage, and various other small electrical services.

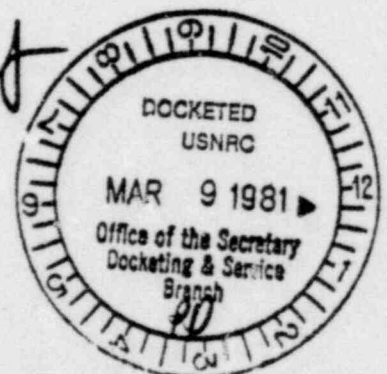
We again appeal to you on behalf of our citizens and to expediate start-up.
