This is in response to your letter dated November 11, 1980 providing comments on proposed exemptions for smelted alloy published in the Federal Register on October 27, 1980. In the last paragraph of your letter you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of each comment and NRC's responses on this proposed rule.
