
Dear Mr. Brown:

In reply to your letter dated April 27, 1981, concerning a deficiency in our response to Violation No 1 of your Notice of Violation dated March 19, 1981, we will amend our response as follows:

1. Our source was tested for leakage by Radiation Detection Company on March 20, 1981. (A copy of this test was submitted to you on March 26 and April 13, 1981). A similar test will be conducted every six months making the next test due on September 20, 1981. We will insure the leak test will be performed by recording the test date on the schedule calendar, located in my office. In addition, Gulf Nuclear Corporation, 202 Medical Center Blvd., Webster, Texas, has agreed to send a leak test kit and notification of our test date two weeks before the test is to be performed.

I hope you will find us in compliance with Violation No 1 of the NRC requirements.


