(1) Corrective steps:

A routine schedule of examination has been established. The first samples will be taken and analyzed during the first week of June 1981.

(2) Corrective steps; Future:


The scheduling of analyses will be supervised by the administrative director. Records will be maintained in the quality control notebook.

(3) Date of full compliance: June 15, 1980

We are now drafting an amendment to our license. It will include the appointment of a qualified radiation officer and two alternates.
