

Dear Mr. Tedesco:



On December 10, 1980, Houston Lighting & Power Company received a letter from your office dated November 25, 1980 (ref. ST-AE-HL-661) in which all licensees of operating plants and applicants for operating licenses and construction permits were requested to submit information relative to commitment dates for meeting the requirements of the May 23, 1980 Commission's Memorandum Order. Your letter indicated that the staff reviews concerning environmental qualification of equipment are being divided into two categories; those plants for which a full power license is expected to be issued before February 1, 1981 and those plants for which a full power license is expected to be issued after February 1, 1981. The South Texas Project should be included under the second category and per the instructions of your letter the required information will be submitted at least four (4) months in advance of the expected date of issuance of a full power license for the South Texas Project.
