In response to the proposal (45-FR 67018) published in the Federal Register of October 8, 1980, to permit the disposal of liquid scintillation media and animal carcasses containing less than 0.05 microcuries of tritium or carbon-14, the Radiation Safety Committee at ICI has considered this proposal at some length. It is the overwhelming consensus of the committee that this proposed amendment be swiftly enacted. The levels under consideration seem reasonable and safe in having little adverse impact from a radiological health standpoint.
