In response to your referenced proposed rule, Florida Power & Light Company submits the following comments. FPL feels that the "NRR Supplemental Staff Position on Personnel Search Requirements, September 30, 1977", with which FPL presently complies, provides adequate assurance that power reactors are adequately protected against sabotage by an insider. The additional requirements for 100% physical pat-down searches for regular plant employees and other licensee employees at certain times adds little to station security but will be detrimental to employee morale and to timely processing of individuals into the plant.
