Dear Mr. Willey:

By letter dated June 27, 2019 (ML19213A277), St. Vincent's Medical Center submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a request for written consent to an indirect license transfer of NRC Materials License No. 06-00843-03. Based on the information provided, the NRC understands that St. Vincent's Medical Center (SMC) became a wholly owned subsidiary of Hartford Healthcare Corporation (HHC). As such, control of SMC was indirectly transferred to HHC, its new corporate parent. We further understand that this transfer did not result in any changes to the licensee name, licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, location of use, or persons responsible for the radiation safety program.

As more fully detailed in the enclosed Safety Evaluation Report, which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, and in accordance with 10 CFR 30.34, the NRC consents to the transfer. Per your letter dated October 28, 2019, we understand that the transaction occurred on September 30, 2019, but the license and the materials subject to the license were specifically excluded. That portion of the transaction will occur immediately following the NRC's written consent to the license transfer. Please note that since this transaction occurred on September 30, 2019, no other action is required. Future changes in the licensee's name, licensed use, licensed materials, licensed location, persons responsible for licensed material, or other changes to the corporate organizational structure require submission of a request to amend the license or a request to transfer the license. NRC approval must be received prior to implementation of the proposed change.
