Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. J. Streeter of this office on August 11-15, 1975 at Yankee Rowe Nuclear Power Station, Rowe, Massachusetts of activities authorized by NRC License No. DPR-3 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Streeter with Mr. W. Jones and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection, and to a subsequent telephone discussion between Mr. Jones and Mr. Streeter on August 16 and 17, Mr. St. Laurent and Mr. Streeter on August 25 and Mr. Johnson and Mr. N. N. St. Laurent on August 27, 1975.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Office of Inspection and Enforcement Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. Within the scope of this inspection, no Items of Noncompliance were observed by the inspector which had not been previously identified and corrected by you.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the items of noncompliance brought to your attention in a letter dated November 14, 1974. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

In addition, our inspector examined those activities conducted under your license relating to the subjects covered in your letters to Region I dated July 25 and August 4, 1975, (Abnormal Occurrence 75-6) and August 8 and 15, 1975 (Abnormal Occurrence 75-7). We note that AO 75-7 involved an Item of Noncompliance and is considered to be an Infraction. As stated in the attached report, this matter has been adequately evaluated and corrected by you and no response to this matter is required. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this




