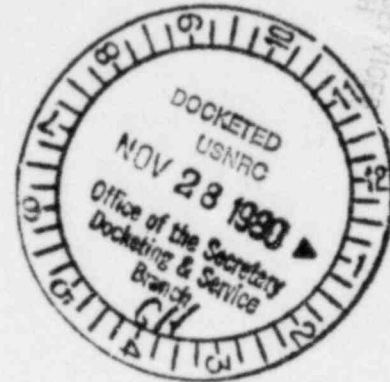

Gentlemen:

As a technician in a small hospital Nuclear Medicine Department I am concerned with the aspects of safety in the use of Radioactive Isotopes. But it appears that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission has not allowed enough time for people in the nuclear medicine field to study the proposed rules for enforcement action published in 45FR69077 and 45FR6654.

In your statement there are no studies to indicate the need for these punitive actions or justification for their implementation. There are no indications as to the cost of this program, nor are there any mechanisms for an appeal process.

I would recommend that this proposal should be withdrawn until an assessment can be made as to the necessity of New Regulations.
