Dear Mr. Denton:

As discussed with Mr. Bill Kane on 12/2/80, South Carolina Electric and Gas Company, acting for itself and agent for South Carolina Public Service Authority, provides forty-five (45) copies of information on subjects relating to TMI concerns.

1. Item I.C.7 - NSSS Review of Procedures

- (a) Emergency Operating Procedures - Westinghouse has reviewed approximately 80% of the EOP's and is currently reviewing the remaining 20%. All resolved comments have been or will be incorporated in these procedures.
- (b) Power Ascension Procedures - Westinghouse has reviewed these procedures and their resolved comments have been incorporated.
- (c) Low Power Physics Tests - Westinghouse has reviewed these procedures and their resolved comments have been incorporated.

2. Item I.C.1 - Short Term Accident Analysis

Based on NRC verbal comments the ATWS and Inadequate Core Cooling procedures were revised and telecopied to Mr. Dave Wigginton on 12/2/80. A followup letter formally documenting these changes will be sent by 12/5/80.



3. Low Power Test Program

The clarifications regarding training during low power tests described in Mr. R. L. Tedesco's 11/14/80 letter to Mr. T. C. Nichols will be incorporated into the test program. As specified in Mr. R. L. Tedesco's 11/20/80 letter to Mr. T. C. Nichols, the procedures will be submitted at least 4 weeks prior to authorization to perform the tests. The results of this program will be submitted at least 2 weeks prior to proceeding above 5% of full power.
