This refers to the inspection conducted by D. J. Perrotti of this office on October 6-10, 1980, of activities authorized by NRC License No. NPF-2 and Construction Permit No. CPPR-86 for the Farley facility, and to the discussion of our findings held with K. W. McCracken at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were disclosed.
