Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter of September 24, 1980, in response to our Inspection Report No. 80-13. As a result of our review of your September letter, we find that additional information is needed for each of the four items noted in our report.

Item 1. Please provide information to establish that adequate steps have been, or will be taken, to avoid future violation in the generic area of securing vital area doors.

Item 2. As in item 1. above, please provide information dealing with steps you plan to take to avoid future violations since all doors and intrusion sensors were not checked, nor does there appear to be a program to assure against system degradation with time.

Item 3. The steps you identify to prevent future violations should deal with the method of counseling personnel and the means of assuring periodic retraining in the area of your security programs.

Item 4. The steps you have taken to prevent recurrence of the violation appear to be incomplete. The words, "passing on of information," as used in this paragraph of your response, could go on indefinitely, thus defeating the intent of maintaining an operational check program. Please provide more information about this situation.


Please submit within 20 days of your receipt of this letter a written statement or explanation in reply to the questions raised in the preceding paragraphs. The
