Per your request by telephone on December 3, this will confirm that the "Historic Dam" referred to in the Memorandum of Agreement has not been affected by the White Mesa Project and is still intact. Moreover, the dam is not even located on the project site.

For reference, I have enclosed ten copies of a portion of the map transmitted to Gene Trager on September 27, 1979. The map is cluttered with other "historical" information, but shows the location of the dam with respect to the mill site and Highway 163.

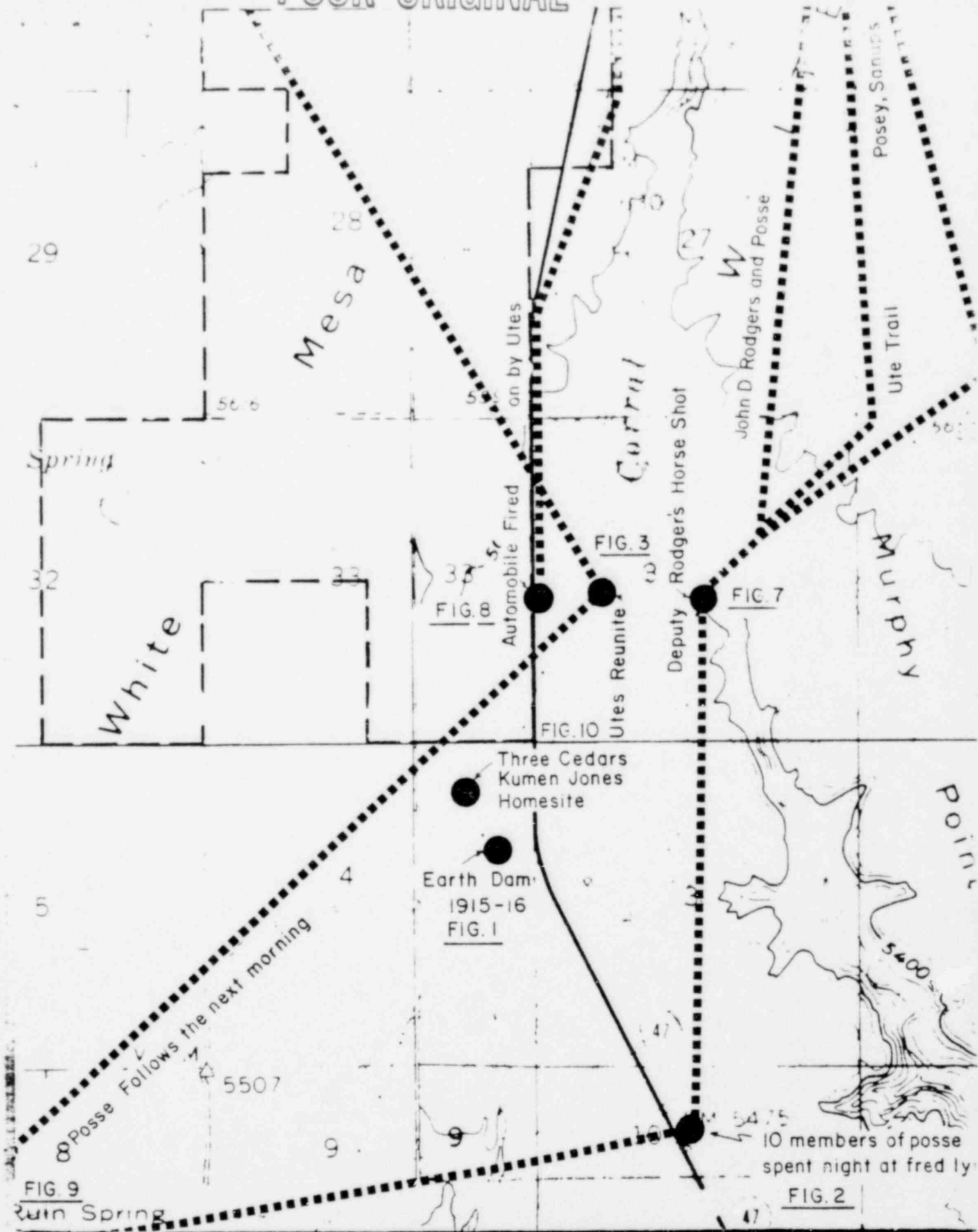
