In your letter of October 31, 1980, you reference requests for action concerning. the Bailly Generating Station, Nuclear 1, that have been filed by the Office of the Attorney-General of the State of Illinois and by the City of Gary, Andfana pursuant to Section 2.206 of 10 CFR Part 2 of the Commission's regulations. 23 You indicate that Northern Indiana Public Service Company (NIPSCC) has not been receiving on a routine basis, copies of correspondence from the Director of Nuclear Reactor Regulation to the State of Illinois Attorney-General's Office or the City of Gary concerning their respective requests for action.

It is the policy of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to provide the licensee with copies of all correspondence from the Director to individuals who have requested action with respect to a licensee's facility. Apparently, through an oversight on our part, NIPSCO has not always been sent copies of such correspondence that concern the Bailly facility. We regret this oversight. Enclosed herein are copies of all correspondence from the Director to the Illincis Attorney-General's Office and to the City of Gary, Indiana concerning their requests for action with respect to the Bailly facility.

You also mention in your letter of October 31, 1980, a forthcoming meeting between the NRC staff and representatives of the Illinois Attorney-General's Office and the City of Gary. This meeting has not yet been scheduled since we are still waiting for issuance of the report by the Federal Emergency Management Agency. The report which has been issued is characterized by FEMA as a contractor is study and is not considered an official publication of that agency. Should such a meeting be scheduled, you will be notified of its time and location and would be welcome to attend.
