The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 12 for the Big Rock Point Plant Facility Operating License No. 303-1. This amendment is in response to your letter of March 8, 1976, modified by letter of March 3, 1977, which requested changes to the Technical Specifications for the Big Rock Point Plant. The changes relate to: (1) General Office and plant staff organizations changes and correction of minor typographical errors in the Administrative Controls section, (2) a reduction of the specified number of non-licensed reactor operators from two to one, and (3) add a definition of surveillance requirements.

Your letters of December 18, 1975 and March 8, 1976, requested changes to the Technical Specifications for the Big Rock Point Plant. The changes relate to: (1) new operability and surveillance requirements for the modified fuel dry-sipping system and (2) recent General Office and plant staff organizational changes and the correction of minor typographical errors in the Administrative Controls Section of the Technical Specifications.

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 11 for the Big Rock Point Plant Facility Operating License No. DPR-6. Changes proposed to the Administrative Controls Section of the Technical Specifications by your March 8, 1976 submittal are included in the issued Amendment except for the proposed reduction of licensed reactor operators from two to one which does not conform to our current requirements. Technical Specifications relating to operability and surveillance of fuel sipping system components as proposed by your letter of December 18, 1975 are not required. Therefore, the proposed reduction of licensed reactor operators and the addition of requirements for the fuel sipping system components are not approved.

Copies of the related Safety Evaluation and the Notice of Issuance also are enclosed.

1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
  - A. The application for amendment by the Consumers Power Company (the licensee) dated March 8, 1976, as modified by letter dated March 3, 1977, complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
