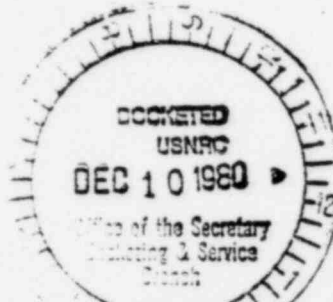

Dear People,
