This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act as amended (5 U.S.C. sec. 552).

As you know, the amended Act provides that if some parts of a document are exempt


from release that "reasonably segregable" portions shall be provided. I therefore request that, if you determine that some portions of the requested records are exempt, you provide me immediately with a copy of the remainder of the record. I, of course, reserve my right to appeal any such decision.

If you determine that some or all of the records are exempt from release, I would like to be advised as to which exemptions you believe cover the material that you are not releasing.

The amended Act permits you to reduce or waive any copying or location fees if that "is in the public interest because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefitting the public." My request is on behalf of the Black Hills Alliance, a duly incorporated, non-profit environmental organization. The information we are requesting is to be used for educating the general public. I believe that this request is in the public interest and, therefore, ask that you waive any fees. Should you decide to assess any fees, I request the opportunity to submit additional information to substantiate a fee waiver.

As provided for in the amended Act, I will expect to receive a reply within 10 working days.
