All documents, records, receipts, memoranda, notes, correspondence or writings or records relating to payments made by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to the Lifespring Washington office, or to any other Lifespring agent, attorney or representative, for or as an "educational credit" to government employees;

All documents, records, receipts, memoranda, notes, correspondence or other writings in the files of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission which relate to Lifespring or address the topic of Lifespring "training" or "educational" programs, including but not limited to any such writings which analyze such programs or purport to justify expenditure of public funds for such programs;
4. All documents, records, receipts, contracts, memoranda, notes, correspondence or other writings or records relating to any contacts, meetings, negotiations or contracts between representatives of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and representatives of Human Factors Research, Inc. or Lifespring Corporation or Lifespring Foundation;
5. All documents, records, memoranda, notes, correspondence or other writings or records relating to an investigation by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission of Lifespring Corporation and/or the Lifespring Foundation, and/or Human Factors Research, Inc. in connection with the planning, development, construction, or operation of Three Mile Island.
6. All documents, records, receipts, contracts, memoranda, notes, correspondence or other writings or records relating to any investigation by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission of any individuals who are or have been members of Lifespring or who have participated in training offered by Lifespring Corporation or the Lifespring Foundation who were involved in the planning, development, construction or operation of Three Mile Island.

We request a waiver of fees incurred in connection with this request. If, however, you deem it necessary to deny the request for a fee waiver, please notify the undersigned before incurring costs in excess of \$75.00 (seventy-five dollars).

If you deem it necessary to deny any or all of the above requests in whole or in part, please notify the undersigned in writing of the reasons for your denial and your agency's administrative appeal procedures.
