

Dear Mr. Barnett:

I will be constructing, for the General Electric Company, a Power Reactor Fuel market demand model. At this time I am collecting historical data from which the basic structure of the model will be built. I am therefore requesting, under the Freedom of Information Act, information on uranium shipments. E. Sparks, Manager, Information Systems Section, NRC, has advised me that this information is maintained on the NIMUS system.

Specifically, I would like data on individual shipments of uranium for the period FY1976 through FY1980. I am interested only in enrichments of 6% or less, including natural, and quantities equal to or exceeding one metric ton of uranium. For each shipment please supply the date, quantity and enrichment. Where possible, please include the point of origin and destination of each shipment. I understand that for material owned by commercial fabricators and/or processors, origin or destination must be withheld, when movement was to or from their facility, to prevent the dissemination of proprietary information, however, I assume this is not true for uranium owned by the Government or a utility. For those shipments for which origin and/or destination information cannot be given, please indicate whether the shipment was domestic, export or import.
