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This is to request disclosure of copies of the following materials available from your agency under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) and implementing regulations of your agency, 10 C.F.R. Part 9, Subpart A:

(1) All documents in the Office of General Counsel, the Office of the Executive Legal Director or the Office of Nuclear Safety Research which are interpretations of or opinions relating to §203 of the Energy Reorganization Act, Pub. L. 96-438.

(2) All documents, including but not limited to studies or evaluations prepared by or for the Office of Inspection and Enforcement, relating or referring to decisions to disseminate information from Licensee Event Reports outside the Commission.

(3) All documents which are interpretations of or opinions relating to 10 C.F.R. 1.64 and which are in the Office of General Counsel, the Office of the Executive Legal Director or the Office of Inspection and Enforcement.

(4) All documents which relate or refer to any NRC evaluation or analysis of the designation of safety related components in Three Mile Island Unit 2 (TMI-2).

(5) All internal reviews by the NRC of any submission by General Public Utilities or any other entity regarding any license application for TMI-1 or TMI-2.

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(6) All internal reviews by any personnel of (or any consultant to) the Division of Reactor Licensing or the Office of NRC of any B&W analysis or topical report submitted in support of licensing of any B&W 145, 177 or 205 FA plant or any B&W Standard 205 plant.

(7) All documents that relate or refer to NRC review or consideration of B&W's letter of December 17, 1976, to the NRC for the 0.44 ft² CFT break, 0.5 ft² RCP discharge break and 0.04 ft² Rep. suction break.

(8) All documents that refer or relate to any change in the Metropolitan Edison Operating License for TMI-2 that are not available in the NRC public document room.

(9) All NRC Safety Evaluation Reports of TMI-2 that are not available in the NRC public document room.

. (10) Any documents which are or refer or relate to NRC's response or follow up to General Accounting Office Reports about the NRC.

(11) All documents which provide interpretations, explanation or guidance of any section of the Inspection and Enforcement Manual, which are not incorporated into the manual.

(12) All documents that refer or relate to the Resident Inspectors Program including but not limited to the decision to implement the program, the choice of utilities and the schedule of Inspector placement.

If you deny any portion of this request, please provide a detailed statement of the reasons for the withholding of each document or portion of document together with an index or similar statement specifically describing the documents or portions of documents withheld. See Vaughn v. Rosen, 484 F.2d 820 (D.C. Cir. 1973), cert. denied, 415, 977 (1974).

To expedite this request, I would be willing to discuss specific instances of deletion or exemption claims in advance of a final decision by the agency. I promise to pay all reasonable charges incurred under NRC regulations for search for and copying of these documents upon presentation of an invoice along with the furnished documents. If the total charges will exceed \$1,000, please advise me of the estimated expense before it is incurred. As provided in the Freedom of Information Act, I look forward to receiving your reply within 10 working days.
