SUNDESERT NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION FOR CONSTRUCTION PERMITS

By letter, dated September 11, 1980, San Diego Gas and Electric Company, applicant, withdrew its application to construct and operate the Sundesert Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. The site was located on the mesa in the Palo Verde Valley in the southeastern corner of Riverside County, approximately 16 miles southwest of Blythe, California.

By Order, dated December 22, 1980, the NRC's Atomic Safety and Licensing Board dismissed the proceeding.

Accordingly, the Commission considers the Sundesert construction permit application to be withdrawn and the corresponding licensing proceeding to be terminated.
