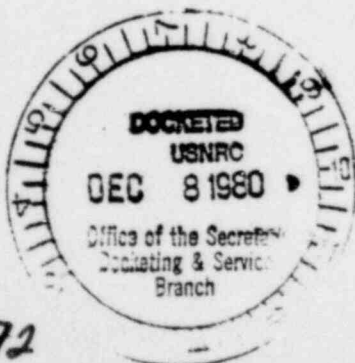
NO THANK YOU!
