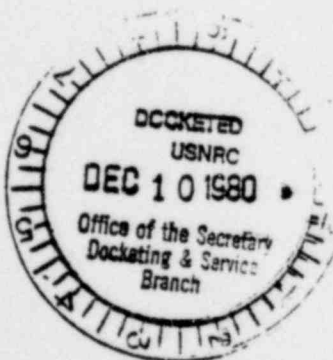
To the Secretary:
