Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Runter of this office on September 22-26, 1975, of activities at Big Rock Point Nuclear Plant authorized by Reactor Operating License No. DPR-6 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. Hartman and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

A copy of our report of this inspection is enclosed and identifies the areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with plant personnel, and observations by the inspector.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities appear to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements. The item and reference to the pertinent requirements are listed under Enforcement Action in the Surmary of Findings section of the enclosed inspection report.

Another infraction identified through your internal audit program which was reported in a timely manner and corrected is set out under Norcompliance Identified and Corrected by the Licensee in the Summary of Findings section of the attached inspection report. No additional information is needed for this item at this time.



In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this notice, the enclosed inspection report, and your response to this notice will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.
