#### 1. GAO Study of NRC Consolidation

An entrance conference for the GAO study of NRC consolidation was held on July 16, 1980, in the Office of the EDO. GAO's study results concerning the options available for the NRC consolidation, as well as its recommendations, will be due at the House and Senate Appropriations Committees by September 2, 1980.

### 2. Joint NRC/DOE Research on Improving Reactor Safaty

This interagency agreement had originally been intended to address FY 1980, but was recently extended to cover FY 1981 as well. Under this agreement, NRC is to review DOE's R&D plans and provide comments as necessary.

### 3. Problem with Westinghouse re Part 21 Reporting Requirements

Westinghouse representative met with IE on July 16, 1980, to discuss its request that IE withdraw the Notice of Violation against Part 21 reporting requirements issued to Westinghouse on October 15, 1979. IE will notify Westinghouse of its decision once the information obtained at the meeting, as well as some additional information to be provided by Westinghouse, is reviewed by the IE staff.

#### 4. Affirmative Action Advisory Committee

I met with the AAAC and discussed a number of the Committee's recommendations. It was a constructive meeting and their comments were well thought out. I will provide the Commission with copies of my response after I receive the minutes.

### 5. Organizational Matters

- a. Consumer Affairs Three People are being selected for detail to OPA to perform the consumer affairs function.
- b. Small Business Office The candidate selected from DOE has accepted. Subject to security clearance, which is in process, he should report to duty in two weeks.
- c. IAEA position I expect to make a selection from the Selection Panel list by the first of August.

## 6. Draft PEIS on TMI-2

On August 6, 1980, the Commission will be briefed on the draft Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement on TMI-2, which is to be printed next week. The Federal Register notice will be published on August 8, 1980.

## Systematic Safety Evaluation Plan

EDO, ELD, and NRR staff are examining Section 110 of the FY 1980 Authorization Act (and the section's history in the Bingham Amendment) to determine the appropriate scope for the development of the Systematic Safety Evaluation Plan.
