The text and authors and dates of publication of the NRC's reported "Findings", referred to by the NRC is paragraphs 1 and 2, under the subtitle, "Proposed Findings", page 70876 of the Federal Register, Vol. 45, No. 209, Monday, October 27, 1980, Proposed Rules. These "findings" are alleged by the NRC, in the aforementioned portion of the Federal Register, to be that no "unreasonable risk... to the health and safety of the public" would be created by the NRC's proposal contained in said portion of the Federal Register to permit certain usage of radioactive wastes in manufacturing, these wastes being incorporated in certain metallic products.
