I am forwarding for your review and comment the Draft Programmatic Environmental Statement relating to the decontamination and disposal of radioactive wastes resulting from the March 28, 1979, accident at Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit 2. The Statement was prepared by my staff in accordance with the statement of general policy and procedure on implementation of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as set forth in the Commission's regulations, 10 CFR Part 51. The Statement has been sent to the Environmental Protection Agency and notice of its availability is being forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication. Comments will be due within 45 days after publication in the Federal Register of the Environmental Protection Agency's listing notifying the public of issuance of the impact statement.
