
Dear Mr. Oplinger:

This is to request a one-year renewal of Export License No. XB000985 issued by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to Texas Instruments Incorporated on February 1, 1980.

In addition to the present authorization of 250,000 curies in electronic timepieces, we request authorization to export 100,000 curies of tritium gas contained in glass-sealed light sources each containing a maximum of 200 millicuries. Subject license, authorizing the export of tritium contained in timepieces not to exceed 250,000 curies, each containing a maximum of 200 millicuries, expires February 1, 1981.
