

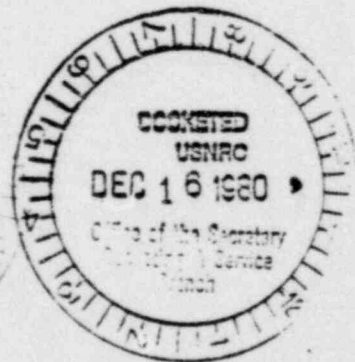
Dear Secretary:

I understand that the NRC is proposing a rule that would exempt the use and transfer of smelted alloys made with radioactively contaminated metal scrap (generated at 3 U.S. uranium enrichment plants) from licensing and regulatory requirements. If this will make it possible for the contaminated alloys to end up in the marketplace, in diluted form - I wish to protest this ruling - before the deadline for public comment passes. Please - see that this crazy "solution" to contaminated metals is discarded. This is a terrible method of handling environmental problems.
