Attention: Docketing and Service Branch Dear Sir:

I protest your proposal to recycle "mildly" radioactive metal alloys for domestic use by the general public (NUREG-0518).

There is no safe level of radiation, contrary to government findings. Each individual's tolerance level varies with his environmental and physical circumstances, and constant exposure to levels of radiation (no matter how low) through everyday contact with coinage, automobiles, cutlery, furniture, and toys - among other items - derived from smelted alloys from reactors would play havoc with the health and well-being of our nation's people, especially the unborn and young children.

I hope your commission has enough common sense to discard this insane proposal.
