

This letter is in regards to restarting the TMI-1 nuclear plant.

Other than the failure (due more to personnel) at the TMI-2 plant, there is no question that the nuclear power plant record is an outstanding one and should be lauded. Since the TMI-1 plant has been modified and the need of less foreign oil is looming because of Arab excessive increases, it would be in the best interest of this country to re-open the TMI-1 plant as soon as possible and also to get back into the groove and build more nuclear plants.
