Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

In Reference (b), Commonwealth Edison Company provided to the NRC a summary description of our conformance to the NUREG 0737 Enclosure 1 implementation dates. For Item I.C.5, we indicated our intent to have procedure revisions in place by January 1, 1981, which provide for feedback of Operating Experience at Dresden, Quad Cities and Zion Stations.

A corporate procedure providing for the operating experience assessment function was in place as required by Item I.C.5 and Zion Station was performing this function as of January 1, 1981. However, the Zion Station procedure revisions implementing this item were not in place until January 30, 1981.

The reason for this delay is attributed to an isolated communications problem between the corporate department coordinating this function and the station, and as such is not expected to recur.
