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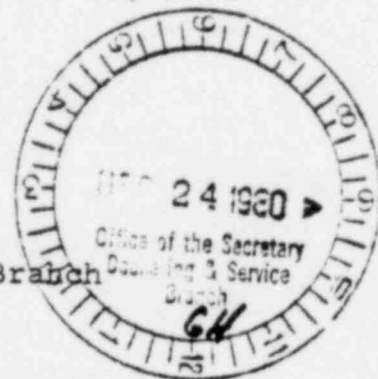

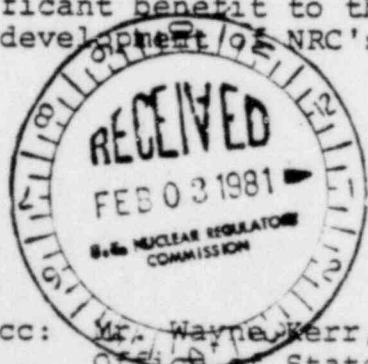
The American Mining Congress is a trade association founded in 1897. The membership includes the producers and processors of nearly all uranium in this country. These uranium producers and processors are represented through the AMC Uranium Policy Council and the AMC Uranium Environmental Subcommittee.
