COMMENTS ON HADDAM NECK GUARD TRAINING & QUALIFICATION PLAN

Our review of the plan indicates that it requires only a limited number of revisions to be acceptable.

Specific Comments

- 1.2.1.38 Add the following information within this section of the plan: "The requirement for a member of the security force to use a hearing aid shall not decrease the effective performance of the individual assigned security job duties during normal or emergency operations".
 - 1.8 Delete the reference to (+ 25%).
 - 1.5 Add to this section a commitment that the documents completed during initial and regualification examinations will be retained for at least a two year period.
 - 2.2.6 Add to this section a commitment that test results will be documented and retained on site for at least a two year period.
 - 2.4 Delete the reference to (+ 25%).
 - 3.0 Add a commitment to perform night firing familiarization.
 - 4.1 Since the handgun course is not the National Police Course, identify the equivalent nationally recognized course used.
 - 4.2 Identify the specific target number to be used as B-27.
 - 5.3 Within this section, identify the personal equipment from Appendix B.V.5 which is to be used.

Job Analysis Worksheets

Watchman 2.2.1

Include within the watchman's re. insibilities that the search is being conducted to detect unauthorized materials and persons in accordance with 73.55(d).

Guard 2.1.2

Add to the guard's duties that the search is being conducted to detect firearms, explosives, incendiary devices and other items which could be used for sabotage.

CAS/SAS 3.1.2

. . . .

Add to the CAS/SAS duties section that operators will be trained to test the system for continuing operability. Modify the duties and tasks column to read, "Monitor Alarm Displays and Sensors to Include the Card Key System'.

General Comments

The Job Analysis Appendix I Worksheets must be revised to add certain crucial guard functions and duties identified in the following sections of Chapter 3 of NUREG-0674:
