On May 17, 1980, Wisconsin Electric Power Company withdrew the construction permit application for Haven 1. On October 19, 1978 Wisconsin Electric Power Company requested that the Commission discontinue the review of Haven 2.

Under 10 CFR Part 170, it is Commission practice to recover review costs using the procedures of Footnote 3 to 10 CFR 170.21 when the review of the project is complete. The review of this project was completed as of July 30, 1980, the date the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel dismissed the proceeding. Accordingly, we have determined the actual expenditures incurred for professional manpower and contractual support services from December 16, 1977, the date the application was amended to change the site from Koshkonong to the Haven location, to October 19, 1978 for Haven 2 and July 30, 1980 for Haven 1. Actual costs for Unit 1 were \$490,742 and \$5,694 for Unit 2. Under the Commission's regulations, we limit the charge for review to that which would be applied to the construction permit under 10 CFR 170.21 A.3, that is, \$490,742 for Unit 1 and \$5,694 for Unit 2. \$125,000 has already been paid as an application fee. The balance due for the review of the construction permit application is as follows:

We have notified the NRC Office of Controller to issue an invoice to Wisconsin Electric Power Company to cover the Commission's review costs.
