- 1. He is Vice President of Philadelphia Electric Company (hereinafter referred to as the "Company"); he is authorized to execute this Affidavit on behalf of the Company; and he has read the revised Plant Security Personnel Training and Qualification Plan for Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station dated March, 1981 (hereinafter referred to as "the Plan"), and knows the contents thereof.
- 2. The Plan which is sought to be withheld from public disclosure contains details of the physical security plan for Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station.
- 3. To the best of his knowledge, information and belief, the information set forth in the Plan has been treated as confidential and proprietary information and has been withheld from public disclosure by the Company in accordance with the Company's practice of treating all information dealing with the details of security plans and procedures as confidential and proprietary information.

4. The Plan should be considered by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission as confidential and proprietary information and be withheld from public disclosure on the grounds that it contains details of the physical security plans and procedures of a licensed facility, such disclosure is not required in the public interest, and such disclosure would adversely affect the interest of Philadelphia Electric Company.
