SUBJECT: REPORT ON IMPACT OF FISSION-PRODUCT IODINE AND FISSION-PRODUCT AEROSOLS ON PAST LICENSING PRACTICE PRESENT REGULATIONS, AND FUTURE LICENSING APPLICATION

In response to the continuing interaction with RES and SD, and related to the State of Technology Report on Release of Fission Product Iodine, Accident Analysis Branch will take the lead on the above subject report (ref.: Arlotto to Dircks memo of December 22, 1980, "Comments on Proposed RES Program ..."). Walter Pascdag will be the task leader for this effort and we expect support from Roger Blond, RES, and Michael Jankowski, FPSSB, SD. Our schedule for the above subject report will parallel the schedule for the RES State of Technology Report, which has a first draft date of January 19, 1981 and the final product proposed for transmittal to the Commission about March 24, 1981. We do not expect to need to reschedule any noticeable amount of work to achieve this output and schedule.
