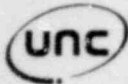




Gentlemen:

Attached for your review and approval is an administrative amendment to license SNM-777. This amendment includes a change to Section 200 to reflect the appointment of Mr. Peter Dessaulles to the position of Manager, Operations. Also, included is a modification to Section 700-Transportation, which will make our waste packaging and shipment procedures a license requirement, and therefore, subject to compliance inspections. This item is submitted in response to a condition imposed by the State of Nevada for our continued use of the NECO burial ground at Beatty. Finally, as R. Gregg discussed with you on October 16, our interpretation of the existing license (e.g. Section 303.3.2) is that outside storage of packaged lagoon materials is acceptable provided that a) it is within the outer perimeter fence, b) it meets the surface density criteria, and c) all applicable safeguards requirements are complied with. Your concurrence with this interpretation is requested.

We would appreciate your prompt review of this submittal, so as to minimize the delays in our decommissioning effort associated with the current burial restrictions. If we can provide any additional information, please contact us.
