I am sorry to learn that the NRC thinks it is sufficient to notify the governor of a state only before nuclear waste is shipped across a state. I think that local Civil Preparedness Agency officials should receive prior notification also. In the event of an accident timing is vital. The sooner CPA officials are on the scene, the greater the likelihood local persons will be protected from the hazardous waste.

Please revise your proposed rules to include notification of local CPA officials.

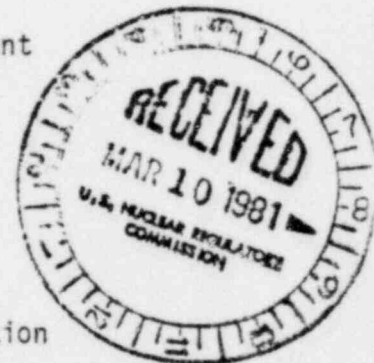

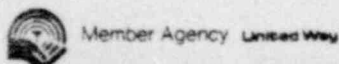
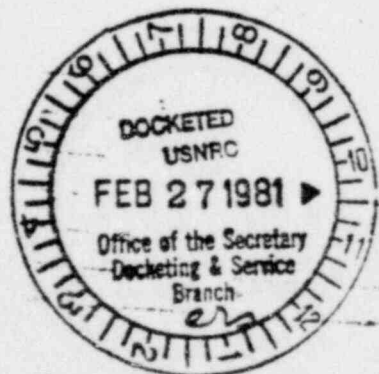
