This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Ms. J. Johansen and Ms. J. McGinness of this office on February 3, 1981 of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. 06-01765-01 and SNM-310 and to the discussions of our findings held by Ms. J. Johansen with Cdr. Charles B. Galley, M.S.C. USN of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your licenses as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your licenses. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspectors, and observations by the inspectors.

Our inspectors also verified the steps you have taken to correct the item of noncompliance brought to your attention in the enclosure to our letter dated July 28, 1976 regarding License No. SNM-310. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
