Under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act, U.S.C. 552, I am requesting access to information that your agency may have compiled concerning the nature and causes (and violations discovered) of an accident at the United Nuclear Corp. plant; 1 Narragansett Trail, Wood River Junction, R.I. on July 24, 1964, which released radioactivity, resulting in the death of Robert Peobody, an employee of the plant who lived in Columbia Heights, Charlestown, R.I.

If there are any fees for searching for, or copying, the records I have requested, please inform me before you fill the request.


