NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO OPERATING LICENSE

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment No. 47, to Facility Operating License DPR-35, issued to Boston Edison Company, which revised the license for operation of the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 1, located near Plymouth, Massachusetts. The amendment is effective as of the date of issuance and is to be fully plemented within 60 days of Commission approval in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 73.55(b)(4).

The amendment adds a license condition to include the Commissionapproved Guard Training and Qualification Plan as a part of the license.

The licensee's filings, which have been hand'ed by the Commission as an application, comply with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. The Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I, which are set forth in the license amendment. Prior public notice of the amendment was not required since the amendment dues not involve a significant hazards consideration.

The Commission has determined that the issuance of the amendment will not result in any significant environmental impact and that pursuant

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to 10 CFR \$51.5(d)(4) an environmental impact statement or negative declaration and environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with the issuance of the amendment.

The licensee's filings dated August 18, 1979, May 27, September 18, and October 24, 1980, are being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(d). The withheld information is subject to disclosure in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR \$9.12.
