In response to your request for additional information dated March 20, 1981, we provide the following information.

The Perry Fire Protection Evaluation Report (FPER) was originally submitted on September 26, 1977 and Revision 1 to the report on January 28, 1981. The FPER describes the detailed design as of December 1979, which conforms to the intent of the guidelines in BTP-APCSB 9.5-1, Appendix A. Included is a fire hazards analysis which evaluates the potential adverse effects of a fire on the ability to safely shut down the plant. Also provided in the report are layout drawings which show the safe shut down equipment and cabling, fire barriers and fire suppression equipment.

The specific information you requested will be tabulated for inclusion in the next revision of the FPER. We expect to have this available for our review by May 15 and submitted to your office before June 19, 1981.
